1. Upon receipt of this application, the Admission, Appeals and Transport Entitlement Team will liaise with your preferred school/s to establish if a place is available for your child. For applications for Community and Voluntary Controlled schools, a decision will be made within 5 working days. For applications for Voluntary Aided (Church) schools and schools situated in other Local Authority areas, a decision will be made within 10 working days.
2. If a place can be offered, you will be notified of this by letter. The letter will include a slip that you must return to the Admissions, Appeals and Transport Entitlement Team within 14 days to formally accept or decline the offer of a place. If you do want to accept the place you will need to contact the Head Teacher at the School to make arrangements for your child to start. **Please note if you do not accept the offer of a place within 14 days, it may be withdrawn and offered to another pupil.**
3. If a place cannot be offered at your preferred school/s, we will let you know how to place your child's name on the school's waiting list and/or appeal for a place.
4. A sibling is defined as: brother, sister, half brother or sister, adopted brother or sister, step brother or sister, or the child of the parent/carer's partner and, in every case, the child must be living in the same family unit at the same address.
5. We reserve the right to seek proof of address and withdraw an offer of a place, if any inaccurate information or address is given on this application.
