PROVISION FOR CHILDREN OF KEY WORKERS AND MOST VULNERABLE

Following our Headteacher meeting and advice from the Local Authority, we will be open from next week for the following children only:

1. Children where **both** parents are key workers and have no alternative provision.

These are:

A.

1. Delivery drivers of essential services e.g. food and medical supplies
2. Front line NHS staff who work in hospitals
3. Teachers/Child care
4. Care home workers
5. Social workers
6. Police officers, Community support, Civilian staff
7. Prison or other probation staff
8. Firefighters
9. Front line staff of Taylor Shaw who provide meals to schools

B.

Single parents of the above categories where the child only sees one parent and has no alternative provision.

Schools will be open 8.00am – 3.15pm.

This arrangement will be reviewed after 2 weeks.

Please contact the Headteacher of your school to confirm that you are one of these groups. We also



need to know which days you require as obviously many of these key workers work shifts so will not require every day. The purpose of this facility is to help key workers and to minimise the number of children in school.

Details around meal provision are just starting to come to us so we will contact you with more information as we have it. In the mean-time, can you be prepared to bring your child with a packed lunch on Monday morning if they are eligible to attend school.
