



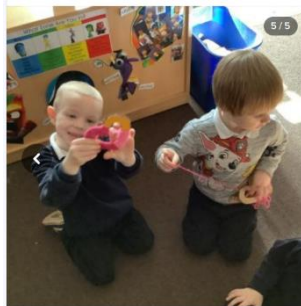
# Sunnybrow News

## NEU Teacher Strike

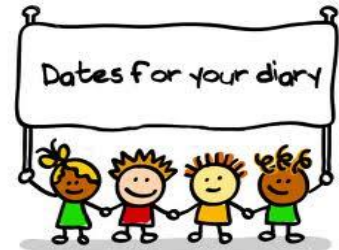
The NEU are intending to strike again on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> February. If the strike action does go ahead, we will be partially opening under the following arrangement:
