Woohoo! Attendance is great this week and we have our first class with 100%! Well done Class 1. They will be getting a treat next week ☺

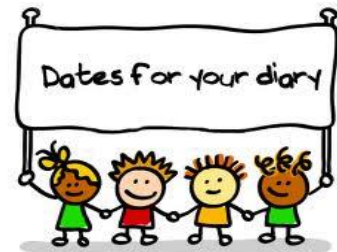


Charity Bag Collection
